

Moon Brook Country Club, Jamestown, NY

MEMBERSHIP

Applications

All applicants for Membership must be proposed and endorsed by two members in good standing not serving currently on the Board of Directors and be passed upon favorably by the Membership Committee and the Board of Directors before being accepted to Membership.

Classifications And Privileges

CLASS A-The Class A member shall be a person, age thirty-five (35) years or older. Members of this Class, in addition to having the sole right to vote and hold office, shall be the only members to share in the distribution of any assets of the Club upon dissolution thereof. Subject to the powers of the Board of Directors to limit the total golfing membership of the Club, the spouse, and any of the qualified children or qualified legal wards of the Class A member, shall enjoy all the privileges of Class A and any other as may be promulgated by the rules and regulations established by the Board of Directors. Qualified children or qualified legal wards shall be unmarried and twenty-one (21) years of age or under as of January 1st of the current year. If at any time the membership of the Class A member shall cease, the privileges of the spouse, qualified children, or qualified legal wards shall also cease. Children under the age of sixteen (16) years shall be entitled to such golfing privileges as the Board of Directors shall designate.

All Class A members shall have pool and tennis privileges as part of such classification with the privilege to the spouse, unmarried children and legal wards who are twenty-one (21) years of age or under as of January 1st of the current year.

CLASS G-Non-Resident Extended Privileges. This class shall consist of persons age thirty (30) years of age or older, whose legal residence is more than fifty (50) miles from Moon Brook and who reside at least six (6) months per year at such legal residence. They shall be extended all the privileges of the Class A except voting, office holding and the sharing of assets in the event of liquidation. This class of member shall have unlimited golfing privileges, pool privileges, and tennis privileges. The same Club privileges of a Class G member are extended to the spouse, qualified children, or qualified legal wards of such member. Qualified children or qualified legal wards shall be unmarried and twenty-one (21) years of age or under as of January 1st of the current year.

SUB-CLASS-S-Senior Category. An addendum to Class A or Class G (i.e., A-S, G-S), this sub-class shall include any Class A or G member who has reached the age of 65 AND whose Class A and/or G membership has extended, continuous or otherwise, through 25 years. Length of membership tenure shall be calculated the same as "Club Age", for example, to the members membership seniority on January 1st following the actual anniversary of that member's election to membership. Dues shall be 80% of the published dues for this class. Full house minimum, 100% of amount specified for member's principal Class A or G shall apply.

SUB-CLASS A-2. This classification is for all members between the ages of 30 and 34 who shall be entitled to all privileges of a Class A member as hereinbefore stated and shall pay an initiation fee, annual dues, and house minimum charges as specified by the Board of Directors until the age of 35. At the age of 35, the A-2 member will be granted full "A" membership, and will pay the appropriate dues, house minimum, and assessments of this class. This class of member shall have unlimited golfing privileges, pool privileges, and tennis privileges. The same Club privileges of a Sub-Class A-2 member are extended to the spouse, qualified children, and qualified legal wards of such member. Qualified children or qualified legal wards shall be unmarried and twenty-one years of age or under as of January 1st of the current year.

CLASS B-GOLFING MEMBER. This classification is for members between the ages of 18 and 29 who shall pay an initiation fee, annual dues, and house minimum charges as specified by the Board of Directors until age 30. At the age of 30, the Class B member will be granted Sub-Class A-2 membership, and will pay the appropriate dues, house minimum and assessments of this class. Any children of a present member will be exempt from the payment of initiation fees. This class of member shall have unlimited golfing privileges, pool privileges, and tennis privileges. The same Club privileges of a Class B member are extended to the spouse, qualified children and qualified

legal wards of such members. Qualified children or qualified legal wards shall be unmarried and twenty-one (21) years of age or under as of January 1st of the current year.

Class B members who are under twenty-one (21) years of age must have on file with the Club a written agreement for some responsible person, acceptable to the Board of Directors, which agreement shall guarantee to pay the dues, assessments, and all house charges of such member.

CLASS C-ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP. This class shall consist of anyone whose spouse was or is a member, divorced or widowed persons, twenty-five (25) years of age or older. They shall have such house and golf privileges as may be determined by the Board of Directors. They shall have pool privileges and tennis privileges.

(This classification was rewritten in 1996. All Class C members at that time were grandfathered in the new class.)

CLASS D-GOLFING, NON-RESIDENT. Non-resident golfing members shall be persons age thirty (30) years of age or older who do not have their primary residence, are not registered to vote, nor do they have a place of business within fifty (50) miles of Moon Brook. Such golfing non-resident members shall have golfing privileges no more than twenty (20) times during any calendar year. This class of member shall have house privileges, pool privileges and tennis privileges. The same Club privileges of a Class D member are extended to the spouse, qualified children and qualified legal wards of such member. Qualified children or qualified legal wards shall be unmarried and twenty-one (21) years of age or under as of January 1st of the current year.

CLASS H-GOLFING, SENIOR. An addendum to Class A, this sub-class shall include any Class A member who has reached the age of sixty-five (65) AND whose class A membership has extended, continuous, or otherwise, through thirty (30) years. Length of membership tenure shall be calculated the same as "Club Age", for example, to the members, membership seniority on January 1 following the actual anniversary of that member's election to membership. They shall be extended all privileges of Class A except voting, office holding, and the sharing of assets in the event of liquidation. This class of members shall have golfing privileges no more than twenty (20) during any calendar year. The same golf privileges are extended only to their spouses. They shall have pool privileges and tennis privileges.

CHILDREN OF PRIMARY MEMBERS AGES TWENTY-TWO (22) TO TWENTY-FOUR (24) AS OF JANUARY 1st OF EACH YEAR MAY PLAY TWENTY (20) ROUNDS OF GOLF PER YEAR AS A GUEST WITH A CURRENT MEMBER. THE PREVAILING IMMEDIATE FAMILY FEES WILL APPLY.

CLASS E-SOCIAL MEMBERS. Social members shall be persons twenty-one (21) years of age or older. They shall have the use of all facilities of the Club except golfing. The same Club privileges of a Class E member are extended to the spouse, qualified children and qualified legal wards of such member. Qualified children or qualified legal wards shall be unmarried and twenty-one (21) years of age or under as of January 1st of the current year.

Social members shall be divided into two (2) classes :

- A) E-A single or married person twenty-one (21) years of age or older. Such member shall be subject to a full house minimum charge.
- B) E1-A non-resident person, single or married, twenty-one (21) years of age or older. Such member shall NOT be subject to any house minimum.

POOL MEMBERS. All membership classes are entitled to pool privileges.

TENNIS MEMBERS. All membership classes are entitled to tennis privileges.
