Cabernet Sauvignon, Beringer 'Knights Valley'
(California) Bright cherry fruit flavors, sweet vanilla oak, and smokey aromas accented by dried herbs and bramblebush scents. \$48.

Cabernet Sauvignon, St. Francis
(California) Spicy aromas of cassis, blackberry and a note of toasty vanilla oak. \$36.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Casillero del Diablo
(Chile) Appealing ripe cherries, black currant & dark plums with a touch of vanilla & toasted oak. \$25.
